MINIS: Rule 15.9

(A) Mini competitors shall compete in age groups. Subject to rule 15.9.(b), except for those turning 12, the age of a mini competitor on the first day of an event or series shall determine their age group for that event or series.

(B) If a mini competitor's birthday falls during an event or series, (s)he may commence an complete that event or series in the new age group. However, nothing in this rule shall allow a mini competitor to ride a capacity or type of mini machine under age.

JUNIORS: Rule 15.19a

Junior competitors age shall be from and including the eighth birthday until the seventeenth birthday.

15.19b When a junior licence holder reaches 15 years they may remain as a junior until their 17th birthday, or they may return their junior licence for a senior licence.

15.19c (A) Subject to rule 15.19c (B), except for those turning 17, in age based competition, the age of a junior competitor on the first day of an event or series shall determine his/her age group for that event or series.

(B) If a junior competitors birthday falls during an event or series (s)he may commence and complete that event or series in the next age group. However, nothing in this rule shall entitle a junior competitor to ride in the 125 classes under age 12.

15.19d Where a Juniors birthday falls during a consecutive multi day event the competitor may complete that event, in that class.

PROTEST COMMITTEE:

MNZ Steward, Club Representative and Rider Representative.

ENTRIES/REFUNDS: Rule 5.5a

All entries must be accompanied by the correct fees. If the rider is unable to attend and notifies the Secretary of the meeting by phone or by written word prior to, but not including the event day or in case of a two day meeting, the practice day, entry fees to be refunded in full if all passes are returned. In the case of a telephone or fax cancellation written application must follow, postmarked before the event or practice day.

LAPSCORING: Electronic lap-scoring will be supplied by Patetonga MCC using transponders.

START: Will be clutch start behind backward falling gates.

GATE POSITIONS: Gate selection for riders will be by practice/qualifying times.

ACCEPTANCE AND CONFIRMATION: Entries will not be processed unless entry form is filled out correctly and payment has been received. Confirmed entry list will be available on www.patetongamx.co.nz prior to close off date.

FORCE MAJEURE: For reasons of Force Majeure, should a meeting or part of a meeting be cancelled any entry fee refunds will be made at the sole discretion of the Organizers. The Organizers reserve the right to alter the meeting format as deemed necessary.

BACK & BIKE NUMBERS: Racing numbers are to be worn on the back of body armour or jersey and on bikes as per rule 10.2b.

NOISE TESTING: Noise testing may be performed with a maximum limit of 96Db, as per MNZ Regulations.

GATE ENTRY: Sunday entry will be free to all competitors and mechanics before 9am.

After 9am all people entering gold coin donation.

RACE DURATION:

Mini class	- 3 x 10 min + 1 Lap races
Junior classes	- 3 x 12 min + 1 Lap races
Vets, Women, Clubman	- 3 x 12 min + 1 Lap races
MX1, MX2, Nat 125cc	- 3 x 15 min + 1 Lap races

15.19c (A) Subject to rule 15.19c (B), except for those turning 17, in age based competition, the age of a junior competitor on the first day of an event or series shall determine his/her age group for that event or series.

(B) If a junior competitors birthday falls during an event or series (s)he may commence and complete that event or series in the next age group. However, nothing in this rule shall entitle a junior competitor to ride in the 125 classes under age 12.

15.19d Where a Juniors birthday falls during a consecutive multi day event the competitor may complete that event, in that class.

MINIS/JUNIORS:

If your birthday affects the class you are in for the event during the series, then you can enter both classes at no extra cost as long as both classes are not run together on the day, else you will have to choose which class. In doing both classes you will only get points in one class for the event and the other for the series.
